Share your study abroad journey with South Australian Government Schools for a chance to win a great prize courtesy of StudyAdelaide. Enter one of the following categories of the competition:

- **Category 1: Video**
- **Category 2: Story with photos**

Entry is open to international students

- You must be enrolled in a South Australian government school in Semester 1, 2019
- You can enter individually or as a group of up to 4. Group entrants can include your local school friends.

Start Creating!

Take us on your study abroad journey including aspects of both your school and home life including your successes and how your study abroad experience has changed you.

For **school life**, you can tell us about your school subjects, co-curricular activities and school friends.

For **home life**, you can tell us about your homestay experience, family and tourism.

Don't forget to introduce yourself, or your group, using your **first name only** and where you are from.

Make sure all content is your own (including video footage, story and photos).

Permissions

Make sure everyone appearing in your video has signed the consent form.

Resources

If you want to use music in your video, there are lots of sites including www.freesound.org; www.bensound.com and www.audiomicro.com that have royalty free music and sound effects.

General tips

If you are producing a video:

- Your video should be no longer than **4 minutes**.
- Produce your video (including sound) in the highest quality possible.
- Any voice audio in the video should be in English; language subtitles can be included as long as they are clearly visible.
- Include a short written description of your video.

If you are creating a story with photos:

- Your story should be no longer than **500 words**.
- Write your story in English and include a copy in your own language.
- Provide no more than **15 high quality digital images**.
- Include images of yourself at school and with your homestay and friends.
- Caption each of your images.

Submit your entry

Submit your entry via email to education.isp@sa.gov.au by **11:59pm Friday 14th June 2019**. If the file is too large, use a file transfer service such as Dropbox to send to education.isp@sa.gov.au.

Don't forget to include:

- » your completed entry form including your parent/guardian signature
- » signed consent form (for others appearing in your video)
- » a photo of yourself or group

Once you have submitted your entry

- Your entry will be judged. Judges will be looking for engaging and creative storytelling that helps them understand your particular journey.
- Winners will be notified by phone or email on 24th June 2019.

Prizes

- Winning entries for each category will receive 1st prize \$500, 2nd prize \$300, 3rd prize \$200.

International Student Digital Storytelling Competition COMPETITION RULES

This competition is offered by the Department for Education trading as South Australian Government Schools CRICOS Provider Number 00018A.

Entry eligibility

1. The competition is open to international students enrolled in a South Australian government school in Semester 1, 2019.
2. You can enter individually or as a group of up to 4. Group entrants can include local students. Each member of the group must submit an entry form.
3. If you are under 18 years you must obtain the consent of your parent/guardian to enter the competition.

Submitting your entry

4. You can submit more than one entry.
5. You must complete the entry form and consent form for everyone appearing in your video and submit them with your video and a photo of yourself or group by 11:59pm Friday 14th June, 2019.
6. You must submit your entry online via email or using a file transfer service to education.isp@sa.gov.au.
7. You must ensure all content in your video (including footage, photos, music, audio and animation etc) is your own, unless using royalty free music.
8. You must not submit any material containing viruses, malicious or inappropriate content.

Once you have submitted your entry

9. The judging panel will be made up of staff from International Education Services, Department for Education.
10. The competition judges' decisions are final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into regarding the judging process or any outcomes reached.
11. Prizes for each category are 1st prize \$500, 2nd prize \$300, 3rd prize \$200.
12. Winners will be notified by phone or email on 24th June 2019.
13. Entries become the property of the Department for Education which reserves the right to use content (including all or part of your entry) in promoting the International Student Program. This includes providing content to authorised third parties for the purpose of promoting the Department for Education International Student Program.
14. All personal information submitted on the entry form is collected for the purposes of administering this competition. Submission of an entry constitutes consent for the Department for Education and authorised third parties, to use the entrant's first name and photo for promotional purposes. Personal information shall not be used for any other purpose without your consent.
