

If you are a full fee-paying international tertiary student studying an award course in a South Australian university or tertiary education institution on visa subclass 500, you can enrol your school-aged children in a South Australian government school for the duration of your visa. Your dependant children must be between 5 and 18 years of age and unmarried.

The tuition and administration fees **below** are paid directly to South Australian Government Schools and not the individual school your children are enrolled in.

If you are granted a bridging visa, your children will require a new Letter of Offer and the **below** fees will continue to apply until the new visa is granted.

Annual Tuition Fees	
Primary School (Reception - Year 7)	\$6000 per child (\$1500 per school term*)
High School (Years 8 - 12)	\$7200 per child (\$1800 per school term*)
Other fees and charges	
Application and administration fee (first year only)	\$660 per family (if all applications processed at the same time)
Annual administration fee (subsequent years only)	\$320 per child
Extension Fee	\$200
Late Fee (invoice payments only)	\$100

The school Materials and Services Charges **below** are paid directly to the individual school your children are enrolled in.

Annual school Materials and Services Charges (Payable directly to the school)	School charges may vary from school to school, depending on the level of services used (ranging from \$110 to \$920 per child). Any clarification regarding school charges must be made directly to the school.

*School terms vary in length from 9 to 11 weeks. The fee per term applies, irrespective of the number of weeks in the term.

Fees are in Australian dollars (AUD) and effective for Letters of Offer that have a study component in one or both of those years. Please note that all fees may be subject to change without notice.

Fees do NOT include travel expenses to and from Australia or visa costs
